

Facilities in the CityCube Berlin

General information

Mobile charging station

The mobile charging station on the entrance level can be used free of charge.

ATM

There is currently no permanently installed ATM in the CityCube Berlin. Mobile alternatives can be provided after consultation.

Monitors

Monitors are available which may be used to process user data. The fact sheet 'Monitors' provides further details.

Parking

A parking area for 120 vehicles + 20 parking spaces for the disabled are available in front of the CityCube Berlin.

Plants

The plants in the corridor between M- and R/S- Rooms are part of the standard interior arrangement.

Seating areas

The Eames-designed seating areas in front of the M-rooms are part of the standard interior arrangement.

Seating in the Cube Café and Cube Club

The furniture in these areas is part of the standard interior arrangement. A fact sheet for these areas is available.

Wi-Fi

Wi-Fi (basic internet) is available free of charge throughout the building. (after prior ordering)
